A RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING AND RATIFYING A PROFESSIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES CONTRACT TO T & M ASSOCIATES FOR PRELIMINARY ASSESSMENT AND SITE INVESTIGATION OF THE FORMER TIMKO-KAGAN PROPERTIES

WHEREAS, Rahway Redevelopment Agency is in need of Environmental Engineering Services; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of P.L. 2004, c.19, known as the “New Jersey Local Unit Pay-To-Pay Law,” the RRA conducted a fair and open process for the provision of environmental services to the City; and


WHEREAS, submissions for the provision of these services have been reviewed and the firm of T & M Associates has been deemed qualified to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq.) requires that resolutions authorizing the award of contracts for a professional service be publicly advertised.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Rahway Redevelopment Agency, as follows:

1. A professional services contract with T&M Associates to provide environmental engineering services in an amount not to exceed \$31,250.00 was approved at the April 3, 2019 RRA Regular Meeting and the Chairman and Secretary are authorized to execute same.
2. This contract shall have a term of one year or upon completion of the project.
3. The contract is awarded without competitive bidding as a “Professional Service” under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A; 11-5) and under the fair and open process of the Local Unit Pay-To-Play Law (N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20-4).
4. The Secretary is hereby authorized to advertise this resolution as required by law. Be it further resolved that the action of the Board of Commissioners of Rahway Redevelopment Agency is hereby memorialized and ratified.
5. This resolution shall take effect upon passage.
