Chairman Robinson opened the meeting with the regulations and reading of the agenda into the record. The following action took place.

SWEARING IN OF BOARD PROFESSIONALS:

Chairman called upon attorney Thomas Malman representing Merck for their application requesting Preliminary Major and Final Major Site Plan approval.

City attorney confirmed that the applicant was ready to be heard. Malman described the application and called Nick Rotonda who was sworn in and accepted as Engineer. Rotonda went over Exhibit A1 which was an aerial of the entire site with a focus on the front entrance facing Scott Ave. Exhibit A2 depicted the proposed conditions that require no variances. Exhibit A3 was a color rendering of the site. Attorney and Engineer touched on all the points on the professional reports and agreed to all the conditions noted.

Floor opened to questions from the Board Commissioners.

Commissioner Shipley complimented the presentation from Merck and asked if they would consider extending the trees to Scott Avenue to update the appearance of that street. Engineer advised that the trees in the rendering are the same as what will be planted and as they grow you will see less of the lot on Scott Ave. There being no other questions, Malman gave his closing summary referencing the site as an improvement to the entrance and thanked the Board.
